Description in brief:





Description in brief:

International Ozone Day 16th September 2021 Department of Botany and Eco Club, Government college for women, Guntur observed International Ozone Day on 16th September 2021. September 16th was designated by the United Nations General assembly as the 'International day for the preservation of Ozone layer.' This designation had been made on December 19,2001 in commemoration of the date in 1987 on which nations signed the Montreal protocol on substances that deplete the ozone layer. The closure of the hole in the ozone layer was observed 30 years after the protocol was signed. Due to the nature of the gases responsible for ozone depletion, their chemical effects are expected to continue for 50 - 100 years. on the eve of observance of World ozone day, to create Awareness among the students, the Department of Botany and Eco club, Government college for women, Guntur in collaboration with department of environmental sciences ANU, Centre for

environmental education and ecological development (CEEED), India, WEO has organized National webinar on 16-9- 2021 at 10 AM on "Judicial Activism and Sustainable Environment." Nearly 100 life sciences students and staff registered and participated in the webinar from the college virtual conference hall. The Chief guest and the keynote speaker was Dr. M.C. Mehata. He is a public interest attorney from India. He won numerous landmark judgments from India's Supreme Court since 1984 including introducing lead free gasoline to India and reducing the industrial pollution falling the Ganga and eroding the Taj Mahal. He was awarded the Goldman environmental prize in 1996 for his continuous fights in Indian quotes against pollution causing industries. He received the Raman Magsaysay award for Asia for public service in 1997. The Government of India awarded him the civilian honor of the Padmasree in 2016 he is a trustee of people for animals. E- certificate was provided to all the registered participants The Director of the webinar was Dr. AVVS Swamy, Professor and Head, Department of environmental sciences, Acharya Nagarjuna University.
