GAARAPADU VILLAGE DETAILS

Activities carried out at GramaSabha level: Grama Sabha

Number of Student/Faculty involvement: 65

Interaction with Local government official: Sarpanch

Brief Description (Discussion points/Impact/Action/Photographs):

The major issues identified by the volunteers in this village are

- Drainage system need to be improved, request for side canals on the either side of road came from many villagers.
- Solid waste management plant which was sanctioned to the village and has yet to be installed.
- School authorities have requested for the construction of wash rooms separately for both girls and boys.
- RTC bus frequency has to be increased.
- Corruption in the village government organisations to be checked



PULLADIGUNTA VILLAGE DETAILS

Activities carried out at GramaSabha level: Grama Sabha

Number of Student/Faculty involvement: 70

Interaction with Local government official: Sarpanch

Brief Description (Discussion points/Impact/Action/Photographs):

There is an NGO organisation “RAITHUNESTHAM” in this village which is helping farmers with organic farming.

The major issues identified by the volunteers in this village are

- There was only one primary school in the village, villagers were asking for a high school as children need to travel 4-5 Km for high school.
- Solid waste management plant which was sanctioned to the village, it has yet to be installed



- Water from the lake is not filter properly and this water is supplied in the village which is leading to allergies.
- Sanitation and hygiene need to improved.
- Even though the village is on the main road and RTC buses move on this road the frequency of ordinary buses stopping in this village is once in two hours. As most of them depend on shared autos they prone to accidents.





CHINTHAPALLIPADU VILLAGE DETAILS

Number of Student/Faculty involvement: 68

Interaction with Local government official: Sarpanch

Brief Description (Discussion points/Impact/Action/Photographs):

The major issues identified by the volunteers in this village are

- There was only one primary school in the village, which was winded up due to poor attendance. Villagers requested to re-open it for the benefit of underprivileged.
- Solid waste management plant which was sanctioned to the village but yet to started.
- Villagers complained of occupation of burial ground.
- Village pond is not regularly cleaned and maintained properly.
- Village suffers from low voltage problem and villagers requested for installation of transformers.
- Permission to construct compost shed was given beside the pond. Villagers are worried about contamination of water if the plant starts functioning and requested to shift the place of compost shed.





KURNUTHALA VILLAGE DETAILS

Number of Student/Faculty involvement: 70

Interaction with Local government official: Sarpanch

Brief Description (Discussion points/Impact/Action/Photographs):

The major issues identified by the volunteers in this village are

- There is acute water problem in the village. The water in the lake is not used by villagers because of legal conflict and repair of filtering plant. People get drinking water from the neighbouring Chintapallipadu village.
- The sanitation of the village is also in poor state. There is no proper garbage disposal system. There are open drains throughout the village.
- There is no health centre or sub centre in this village. Health and hygiene are the most neglected sectors here.
- Village has only one primary school which is ill equipped with facilities. The students of this school are from BPL families and are deprived of basic needs like clothing, books, study materials etc. malnutrition is prevalent among most of the students.





VINJANAMPADU VILLAGE DETAILS
