## GOVT.COLLEGE FOR WOMEN (A) GUNTUR Internal Quality Assurance Cell Action Taken Report on Feedback 2021-22

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college has full-fledged wing which plans, conducts, and analyses feedback on courses, programmes and teaching given by the stake holders i.e., students, employees, alumni, and faculty. The feedback is taken twice a year on courses and annually on other aspects that are mentioned above. Feedback is taken online using the questionnaire suggested by NAAC but by adapting it to the context of the institution.

## Feedback on Programmes & Courses:

The feedback on Programmes & Courses for the year 2021-22 is collected, analysed, documented as a report, and is placed in the college website. The consolidated report carries course wise observations and recommendations, a result of the analysis, for all the 6 semesters of each discipline. The same is communicated to the departments, in hard copy, which is duly acknowledged by the I/C or members of the department. The departments are instructed to note the observations and recommendations and incorporate the necessary inclusions and modifications accordingly. So, as per the current year analysis of feedback on programmes and courses, the IQAC and Academic Council of the college have made the following recommendations so that they could be incorporated to the BOS of the forth coming academic year.

- Having observed the overall positive feedback by students, the alumni and those of the industry it is decided to bring in a few more aspects of practical learning to the core courses. Departments are guided to bring in practical hands-on aspect into the curriculum of courses, especially core courses.
- So, departments of English, Computer Science and Mathematics are advised to emphasize on employability aspects by focusing more on skill aspect.
- Similarly, department of Botany is advised to plan for the introduction of allied courses like Horticulture to increase the employability quotient of the programme.
- Likewise, humanities departments are advised to plan for introduction for mathematics-based programmes with Statistics and Economics.

## Feedback from Teachers:

The committee under the chair of the Principal has gone through the feedback given by teachers on various aspects of Curriculum. Majority of the faculty are satisfied with the update of curriculum design which is relevant to the current job trend. Some of the faculty recommended to equip the departments with internet facility and printers. So, steps have been initiated to provide high speed internet facility and printers to all the departments.
