Activity-1 Atma Nirbar Bharat Webinar


Objective: To promote efficiency, equity and resilence and inculcate the spirit of national integration and communal harmony among the cadets


Cadets participated in the online quizzes, posters presentation, poem and slogan writing, singinging etc

Outcome: Acquired basic knowledge, improved skills and increased gratitude towards Daring Jawans.
















Activity-4 EBSB Saptah Camp (Ek Bharat Shreestha Bharat Camp)




Activity-6 Webinar on NEP 2020


Objectives: To create awareness about National Education Policy 2020 in making India a Global Superpower





Activity-9 Cancer Day Awareness programme

Objectives: To educate the cadets and also to create and spread awareness about Cancer among the citizens and encourage its prevention



Outcome: Many people were impacted by the cadets about Cancer and its prevention. The posts of cadets in the social media also effected many.











Activity-10 Constitution Day




Activity-14 World AIDS Day

Outcome: The cadets gained knowledge of harmful HIV/AIDS epidemic and impacted their near and dear ones by sharing the knowledge.










Activity-15 NCC Online Classes

Outcome: Enable the cadets to develop the team spirit and patriotism. All the teaching, non teaching staff, students and NCC cadets attended and celebrated this national festival








Activity-18 Celebrations of 50 years of 1971 war: Vijay Diwas 2021



Outcome: Gained and spreaded the awareness about the importance of trees for a better ecosystem.











Activity-28 fit India freedom run 2.0 (Fit India movement: 2021-2022)
