

Objectives: To equip the cadets with leadership qualities, create awareness about the Indian armed forces and career opportunities present in Indian armed forces.







Activity No 33: IGOT training to the cadets for covid-19

Objectives: To deal with exponential or geometric increase in COVID-19 positive cases during the pandemic

Description: India is fighting against COVID-19 Pandemic and India's first line of workers is already engaged in COVID relief and doing commendable job. However, a larger force will be needed to replace the first line and to tackle the exponential or geometric increase in positive COVID cases in the subsequent stages of the pandemic. The IGOT platform, Integrated Government Online Training provides the training module on flextime and on site basis so that the COVID response can be delivered at scale for the workforce needed to tackle the pandemic. With regards to this, 52 NCC cadets of Govt.
