On March 16, 2024, the inaugural day of the program was dedicated to the commencement of a special camp organized by the NSS Unit - III under the guidance of the program officer of Government College for Women (A), Guntur. The camp took place in the Slums of Gayathri Nagar, Bhanu Prasad Colony, Sasank Goyal Colony, and Krishna Babu Colony. Dr. V.R. Jyotsna Kumari, the principal of the college, was present alongside Ward Corporator K. Guravaiah, Dr. V. Parimala from the Area Hospital, Dr. D. Dhatri Kumari, the program officer of NSS Unit - II, Dr. K. Priyadarshni, a member of the Unit - 3 College committee, and local Ward Sachivalayam Staff from Wards 76 and 77. They addressed and motivated the volunteers. The Corporator briefed the volunteers about the awareness activities planned for the camp. The program officer of Unit - 2 also outlined the activities scheduled for the camp, while Dr. Parimala encouraged the volunteers with her message concerning health awareness programs to be conducted during the special camp.

Objectives:

- To enhance sanitation conditions in slum areas by removing accumulated waste and disinfecting the surroundings with bleaching powder.
- ➤ To Reduce the risk of waterborne and vector-borne diseases by eliminating breeding grounds for mosquitoes, flies, and other disease vectors through cleaning and bleaching.
- ➤ To Educate slum dwellers about the importance of cleanliness and hygiene practices to prevent the spread of diseases and promote overall health and wellbeing.
- ➤ To Empower slum dwellers by involving them in the cleaning process, fostering a sense of ownership and responsibility towards maintaining cleanliness in their community.

Brief note:

National Service Scheme UNIT - III (NSS)of Government Women's Degree College in local Krishna Babu Colony, Gayathri Nagar, Bhanu Prasad Colony and Sasank Goyal Colony in Guntur, Unit-3 as part of special camp from 16th to 22nd of this month for a week and various topics and service programs will be organized according to College Principal Dr. V. R. Jyotsna Kumari informed. K. Subbarathnamma, National Service Scheme Program Officer informed that as part of

the program on the second day, bleaching powder was poured in front of every house in the 21st ward of Krishna Babu Colony and the surrounding areas of the colony were cleaned. Apart from that, NSS students along with the staff of the 76th Secretariat went to every house and collected about the health condition of everyone in the house. The parents have been informed that the injections like vaccinations to be given to children should be used on time. This camp was visited by Guntur District National Service Scheme Coordinator Dr. J. V. Sudhir Kumar given the massage that each N S S Volunteer should work with dedication and perform service activities without expecting results. In the program, 21st Ward Corporator Shri. K. Guravaiah, Area Hospital Doctor K. Parimala, Hospital CO Smt. A. Bhagyamma, A N M. Aruna and Secretariat staff were participated and also T J P S Degree college NSS unit - 2 Programme officer Dr. Jayaseela garu visited and encourage the students.

Outcome:

- Assess the level of cleanliness achieved in the targeted slum areas compared to the initial condition before the activity. This can include the reduction of visible waste, debris, and other unsanitary conditions.
- Measure the extent to which hygiene awareness and practices have been promoted among slum dwellers. This can involve conducting surveys or interviews to gauge changes in behavior related to waste disposal, personal hygiene, and sanitation practice.
- Evaluate the impact of the cleaning and bleaching activity on reducing the risk of waterborne and vector-borne diseases in the slum areas. This can be done by monitoring disease incidence rates before and after the intervention.
- Evaluate the environmental impact of the activity, including the reduction of pollution and contamination in the slum areas. This can involve measuring changes in air and water quality, as well as the overall improvement in environmental health indicators.

To Encourage individuals to prioritize their physical and mental health by abstaining from alcohol and drugs, thus fostering a harmonious family environment.

> To Develop Healthy Coping Mechanisms

> To Create a safe and secure home environment by eliminating the potential risks and dangers posed by substance abuse, thereby protecting family members from harm.

➤ To Minimize the financial strain caused by excessive spending on alcohol or drugs, ensuring that resources are allocated towards essential needs and family priorities.

Brief Description:

As part of the special camp, awareness rallies were conducted by the Government College for women A, Guntur. NSS UNIT - 3, principal Dr. V.R. Jyotsna Kumari, told that regarding the harmful effects of alcohol consumption, smoking, various types of drugs, tobacco, gutka, and other intoxicating drinks. She emphasized that families should stay away from these substances as they cause significant losses to family values and life itself. It was highlighted that without any value in society, family, village, or country, one should live a healthy and happy life. Therefore, it was suggested to completely prohibit substances like alcohol and smoking. Mr. K. Guravayya garu, the corporator of Ward 21, emphasized the importance of this program and its impact on family values.

Mrs. K. Subbarathnamma, the organizing authority, stated that the youth nowadays are indulging excessively in drugs and alcohol, destroying their lives, and thereby causing significant harm to society and the nation. She stressed the need to eliminate such evils and ensure a better future for everyone. 50 students along with 76 members from the Secretariat staff joined the rally and explained the details about the disastrous situations caused due to alcohol consumption.
