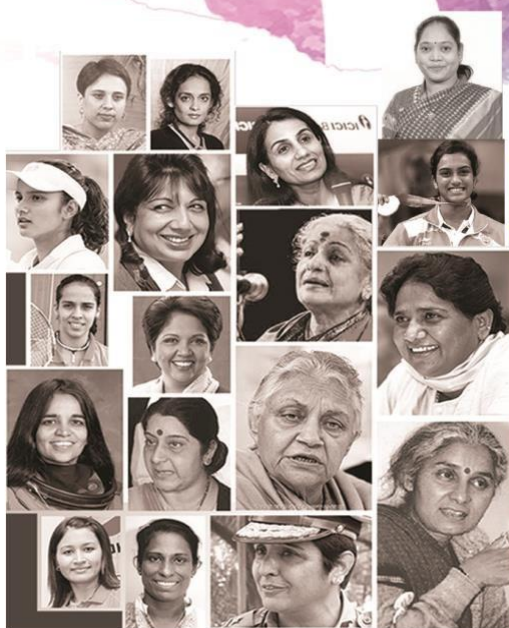

Description: Women Empowerment Cell Guntur conducted a Free Dental camp for students and Staff members. This camp was conducted in association with Pardha Dental Hospitals Guntur. Students and staff utilized this opportunity. Dr. Anusha and her Team examined and suggested medication and also distributed brochures for free consultation
