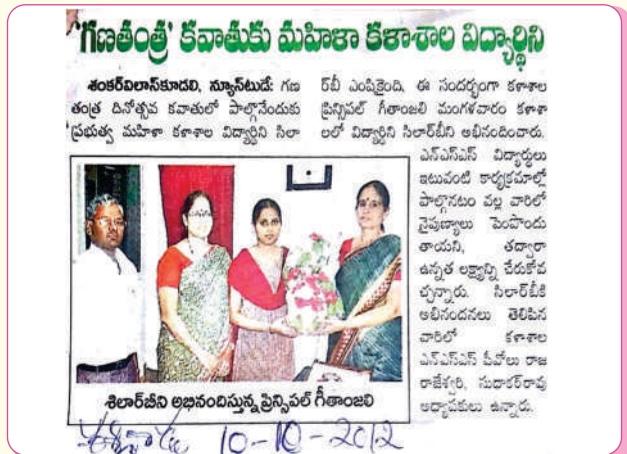

# National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2012-13

1. Participated in biodiversity conference in United Nations Conference Of All Parties (UNCOP II) held at Hyderabad, and presented a skit "Panchajanyam" and bagged prize there.
2. Participated in "bare foot walk" which entered into Guinness book World records. This walk was organised by Acharya Nagarjuna University. 200 students + 10 staff participated in this event which was organized on 12th Dec 2012.
3. Shilarbi an NSS volunteer was selected to attend republic day parade on 10-10-2012. She was felicitated by the principal Dr N. Geethanjali on this occasion.



# National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2013-14

The following activities were conducted under NSS.

1. **WORLD'S AIDS DAY:** On December 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 world's AIDS day was celebrated. A rally was organised from the college to the DHMO office to spread awareness to the public about AIDS. 200 students participated in this event. This event was collaborated with Red Ribbon club of college.



2. On 14th Dec 2013 a rally followed meeting was organised by revenue department on awareness of use of solar energy and to understand and spread the utility of renewable resources like solar energy about 100 students participated in this event.





3. From 12th to 14th Jan 2014 110 volunteers participated in Vivekananda Youth Festival. This festival was organised to inculcate team work and service motto to the students. This programme is organised in collaboration with Government of Andhra Pradesh.



4. Ticket checking drive training and implementation of the activity was taken up by south central railways on 29th Nov 2013. 200 volunteers participated in this training and executed it in the Guntur railway station. Volunteers got awareness about functioning of railways.





## National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2014-15

1. 10 NSS volunteers participated in pre A.P. STATE BEST TEACHERS DAY on 5-9-14, at college campus. They involved in stage work at Police parade where A.P. STATE BEST TEACHER AWARDEES are taking the certificates.
2. On 11-9-14, 20 NSS volunteers participated in literacy drive in Agatavarappadu' village, Guntur district. They did door to door survey about literacy details of villagers, nearly 45 houses were covered. They gave awareness about the importance of education. If a girl gets educated in a family both families get benefited at mother's house and father-in-law's house. The survey came to notice the literacy is very poor in that village. The volunteers decided to form literacy clubs and doing the job of minimum education.



3. On 10-3-2014 on the occasion of special camp the following events were conducted at Agarthavarapadu village.

- A medical camp was organised in Agarthavarapadu village with the cooperation of Dr Balasudha Medical officer of Venigalla village, Pedakakanimandal, Guntur Dt.
- NSS Volunteers organized Rally in the streets of village, later they did door to door survey on occupation, details of family members, literacy, health condition, any addictions, are they are using toilets/open toilets.
- Assistant Director of Horticulture Sri. Krishna Murthy, of Guntur district attended as chief guest and addressed to the villagers about the importance and development of kitchen garden and distributed the plants Guava, Amla, Drumstick, mango etc. Nearly 200 plants are given to the villagers.
- Awareness program on health, hygiene, literacy at AVN colony, Agatavaparapadu village. Competitions held on songs, dance and elocution to MPP school children of AVN colony.
- Signatures are taken from villagers seeking for arrangement of RTC bus facility with the help of district authorities. Valedictory function was organized and certificates, gifts distributed to the winners by chief guest Sri. Ch. Pulla Reddy, Vice principal, Govt. College for Women, Guntur.







4. On 15-11-2014, 15 NSS volunteers participated in Neeru - Chettu Program. They guests created awareness among NSS volunteers from different colleges about the importance of water and trees. Volunteers planted saplings in this programme.
5. G.Amani and N.HarikaIIB.Sc., B<sub>2</sub> went to pre Republic day camp selections at ANU on 12-9-14. She is the only student selected for preRD camp to be held at New Delhi and she went for training from 12-10-14 to 21-10-14.
6. Hud Hud cyclone Relief fund: 50 volunteers collected funds for Hud-Hud cyclone victims. This fund was handed over to Sri. K. Lakshmana Rao, M.L.C and Dr. N.Geetanjali, Joint Director of Collegiate Education Hyderabad, to be donated to A.P. Hud -Hud cyclone C.M Relief fund.
7. Worlds AIDS day was observed on 1-12-2014 by conducting a rally with NSS volunteers and students of the college from college. 300 students participated in the rally which started from college till DHMO office.







## National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2015-16

1. On 4th Sep2015, 60 volunteers participated in teacher's day function organized by Lion's club, Guntur. In this programme senior teachers from various schools and colleges including our principal were felicitated. The programme was held in vajram hotel.



2. 16th Sep2015 A Flash Mob was performed on the topic Traffic rules and their violation at Hindu college centre, Guntur. Nearly 200 volunteers participated. The programme contained dance performances followed by a skit on effects on violation of traffic rules.



3. A dental camp was organized in collaboration with Lion's club & Sibar dental college for staff & students on 21st Sep2015 in the college

premises. Nearly 500 students got their dental checkups and students with dental problems were given medicines and pass for further treatment.



4. On 3rd Dec2015, on the occasion of "World Disability Day"an awareness programme was conducted at various schools and banks towards the needs of differently abled people.80 volunteers participated in the programme and they went to the schools and banks to sensitize the school students and the bank staff about the need of ramps and other facilities for physically challenged people. This programme was done in collaboration with NGO 'Samarthan' trust.





- A rally was organized on "Worlds AIDS Day" from college campus to DHMO office 1st Dec 2015. 250 volunteers participated in the event,



- 200 volunteers enrolled in MANAVA SEVA, an innovative programme started by Govt. General Hospital, Guntur. It is an annual programme where volunteers render their services to patients once every month. This programme started on 26th Jan 2016 at GGH and our volunteers participated in the inaugural.



- On 5th March 2016 an awareness programme on traffic rules was conducted by traffic police, Guntur in the college campus to spread awareness about traffic rules, guidelines for registration and need for safety measures to be followed during driving. 200 students participated in this activity.

# National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2016-17

1. A review meeting on "MANAVA SEVA" which started in January 2016 was held by manavaseva organizers in GGH, Guntur on 22nd July 2016. This also represents the 1st anniversary of the programme. Awards were given to the volunteers who have done extraordinary work. 50 students participated in this event.





2. On 20th Aug 2016 Sadbhavana Divas was celebrated in collaboration with STEP officials to commemorate the birthday of former prime minister Rajiv Gandhi which is celebrated as national integration day. This programme was attended by the teaching staff & 200 volunteers.



3. International Peace Day was celebrated with a meeting followed by a rally in collaboration with Inner wheel club, Guntur on 21st Sep 2016. 200 volunteers participated in this event. MLC Ramakrishna and DSP Saritha were the guests for this programme.





4. "A STREET PLAY" on "Say no to plastic" was staged at Naaz centre, Guntur on 9th Sep 2016. 200 volunteers participated in this activity. This event was done with collaboration with chemistry department to spread awareness about harmful effects of plastic in public.



5. Four Rotaract clubs were started under rotary club of Guntur with all the 200 NSS volunteers as members on 11th Nov 2016. The main aim of this programme is to develop leadership and service motto among the youth.



6. Special camp was conducted with clean and green as main theme at Acharya Nagarjuna University 21st to 27th Nov2016. 100 volunteers participated in this camp. This was a day night camp and volunteers stayed for the whole week in the university campus.



7. On 1st Dec2016 a rally on "World Aids Day" was organized from college campus to DHMO office. 200 volunteers participated in this event.





# National Service Scheme (NSS) Out reach activities 2017-18

1. 8 NSS volunteers participated in the District Youth Exchange Programme conducted in Chittoor District by Dept. of Youth Services, Govt. of A.P from 7th to 9th July 2017. These volunteers visited various places in Chittoor district to study the culture, social, and architectural heritage of the district.



2. On 19th Aug 2017 "Sadbhavana Divas" or national integration day was celebrated in collaboration with STEP and oath was taken by 250 students to spread peace and harmony among the people.





3. An awareness programme on eye donation was conducted in collaboration with an NGO organization 'SAKSHAM'. Blind fold walk was taken up as a part of this activity 21st Aug 2017. 300 NSS volunteers participated in this programme.



4. 100 volunteers participated in 'Clean and green' programme in Acharya Nagarjuna University from 22nd to 24th Aug 2017.



5. A door to door survey camp on eye problems and ODF was conducted at Ponnekallu village in collaboration with Saksham on 15th Oct2017, with 60 volunteers. The volunteers identified the people with eye complications and educated the villagers on need to use toilets.



6. An awareness programme on eye donation by Dr. Lakshmi, was conducted in collaboration with NGO Saksham on 18th Nov2017. This programme is to train students to identify various eye diseases and cornea related problems. 100 volunteers participated in this activity.





7. A door to door survey camp on eye problems and ODF was conducted at adopted villages Pilladigunta & Kornuthala village in collaboration with Saksham with 100 volunteers on 19th Nov 2017.



8. On the occasion of Road safety day, a meeting was arranged in the college premises with RTO as chief guest and 300 volunteers attend the meeting on 27th Nov 2017. An oath was taken to follow the safety rules.





9. On 3rd Dec2017 an ODF survey at Budampadu village was conducted with 60 students. This programme was initiated by the Commissionerate of collegiate Education A.P.



10. A blood donation camp in collaboration with GGH & HDFC was conducted on 5th Dec2017. Nearly 100 volunteers came forward to give blood but only some of them were eligible to donate blood.



11. 52 NSS students volunteered as flag bearers in the inaugural function of Inter University Athlete meet held at ANU on 12th Dec 2017.



12. Janmaboomi is programme designed by A.P state Government to propagated and spread awareness among the people about various programmes and schemes available to public. This programme starts on 1<sup>st</sup> Jan and ends on 11<sup>th</sup> January. These eleven days under various topics like health, animal husbandry, e-governance etc. events are conducted at both the college campus and adopted villages. NSS units also participate in the gramasabhas to educate and understand the problems in the village. Our NSS wings have participated in this programme from 1<sup>st</sup>



January to 11<sup>th</sup> January and organized various events both in the college and also in the adopted villages.



On this occasion NSS volunteers collected funds and donated sports materials and slippers to students of primary school in the adopted villages.





13. Two NSS volunteers Deena Sharma and Ananya both of 2nd Bsc attended the NSS youth festival conducted in greater Noida, New Delhi. They represented Acharya Nagarjuna University in this meet from 12th to 16th Jan2018.



14. NSS Volunteers collected clothes from students and staff and distributed them to old age homes & Orphanages. 80 students participated in this event.

15. A Special camp was organised in the adopted village Kurnuthala for one week. Various activities like tree plantation, rally on ODF & Swatch bharat, Donation of swings & Slide to the Primary school & Medical Camp were conducted in the camp which was held from 26<sup>th</sup> Feb to 4<sup>th</sup> March 2018. 150 volunteers participated in the camp.
