- The IQAC, Academic Council and Board of Studies of various Departments upgrade and improvise the Curriculum keeping in view the consolidated opinions of the Stakeholders.

This information is announced to students in regular meetings / through PA system of the college / announcing in Assembly / through whatsapp groups of classes.

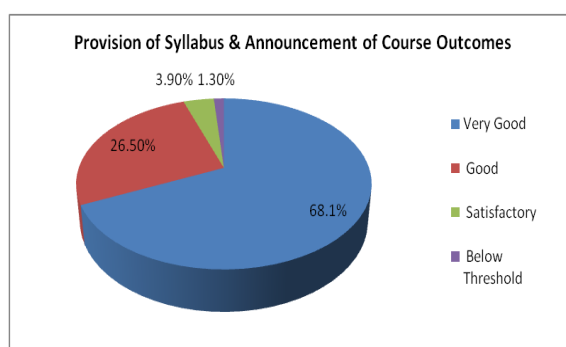

The above table reflects that the feedback on curriculum is good as almost every response is above 60% satisfactory level.

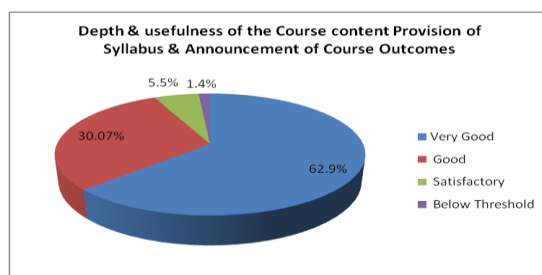

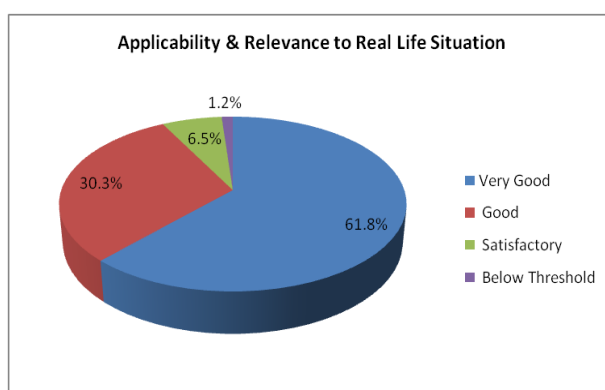

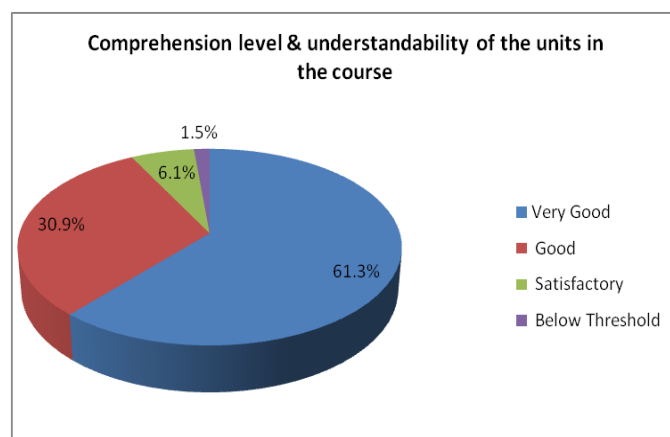

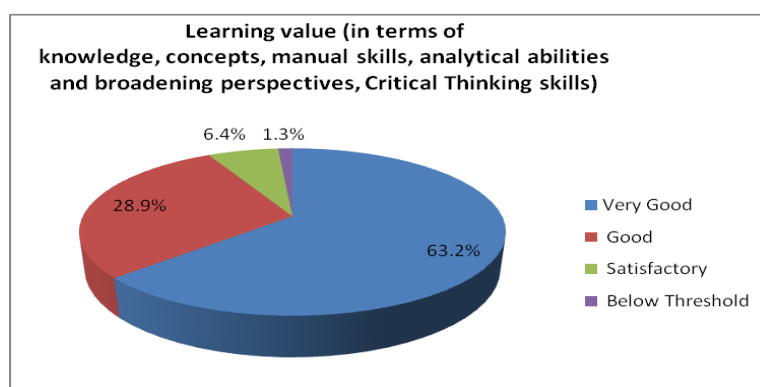

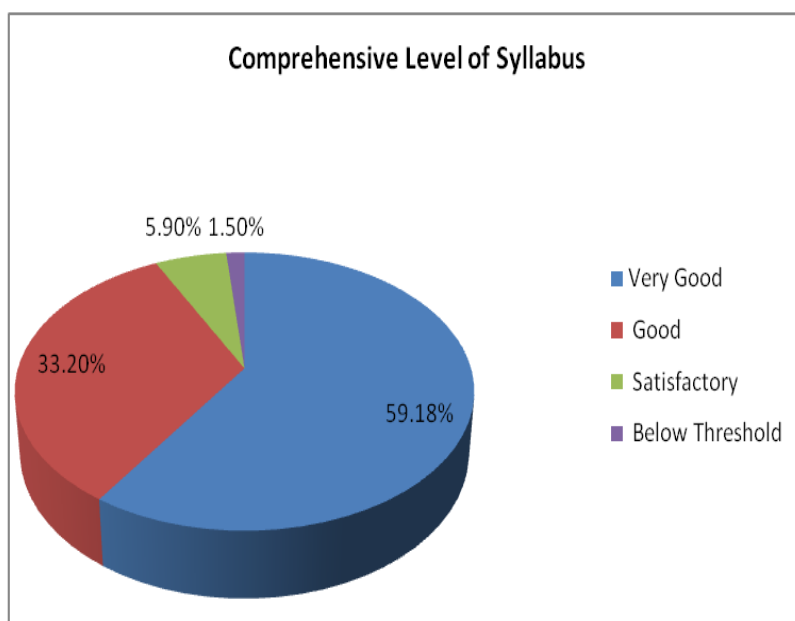

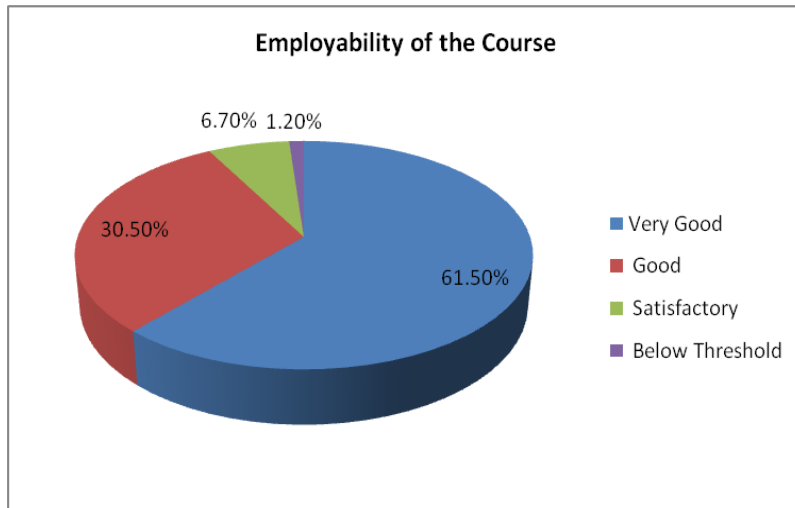

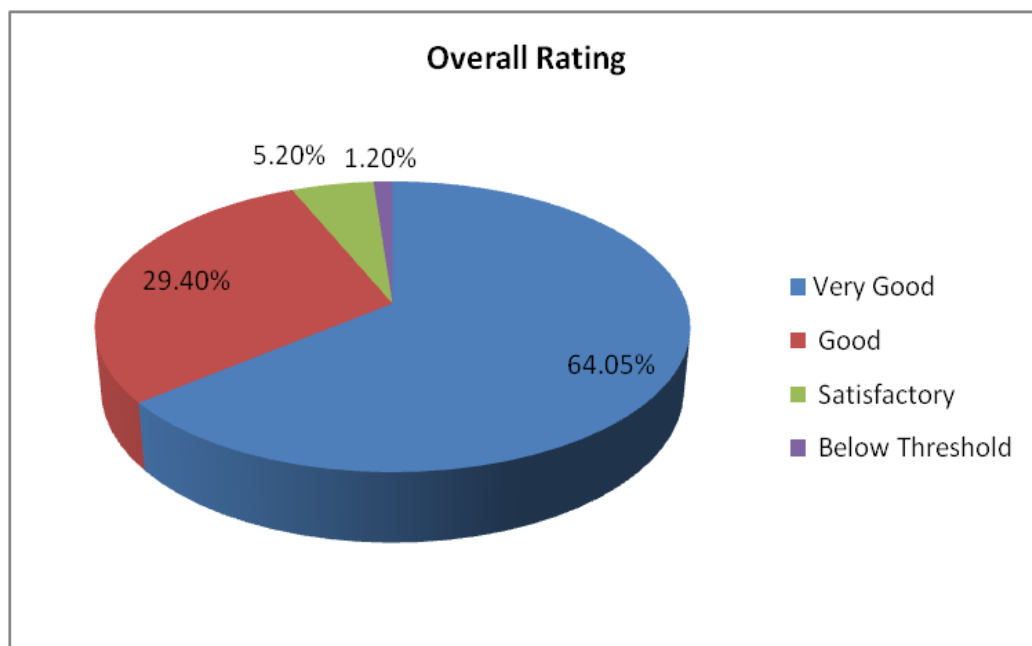

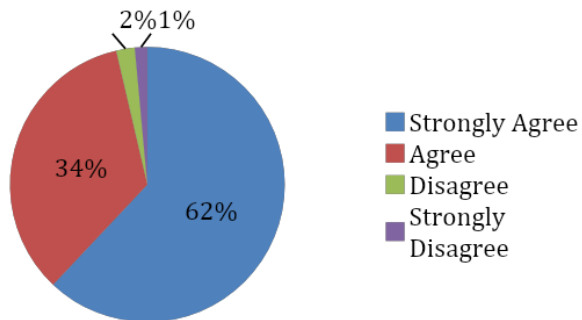

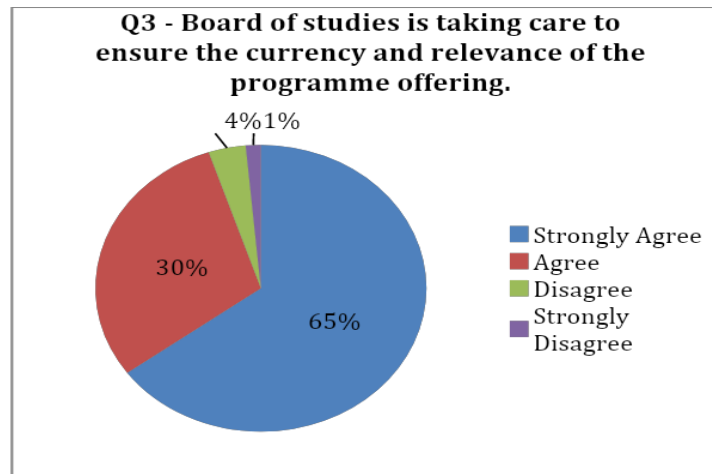

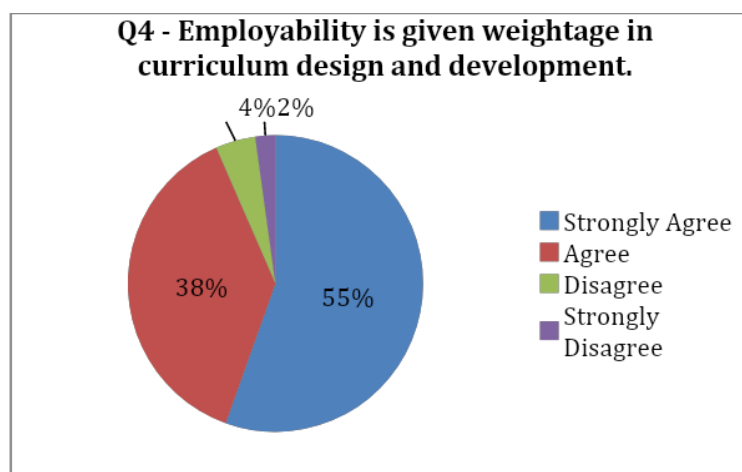

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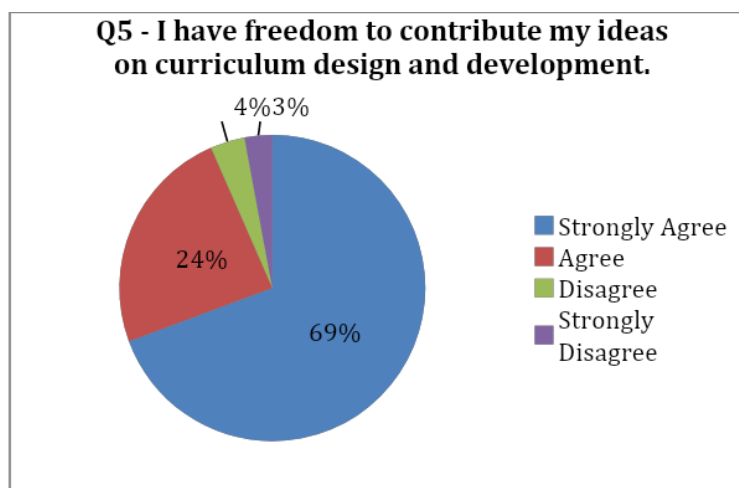

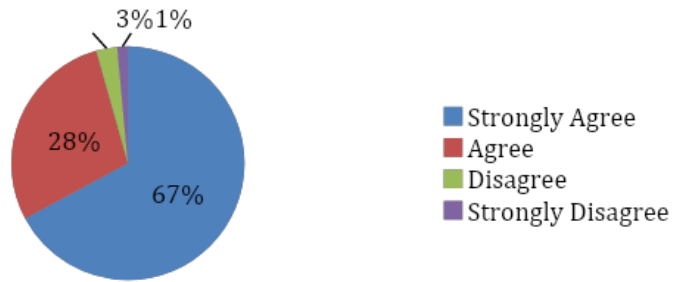

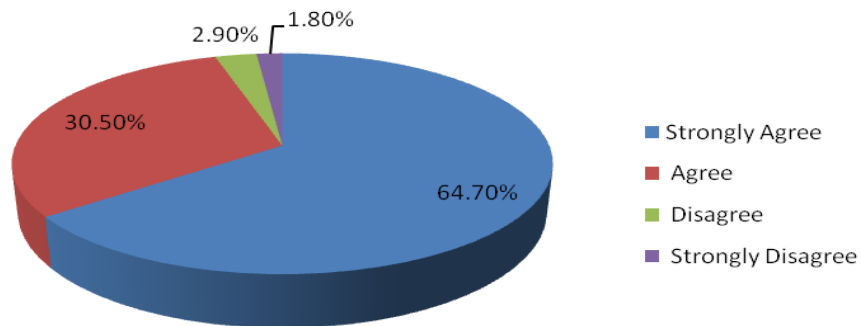

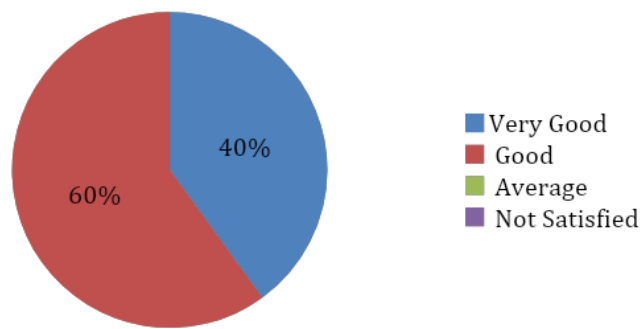

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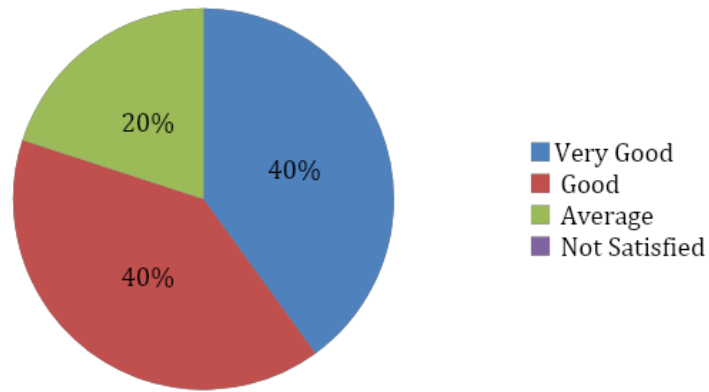

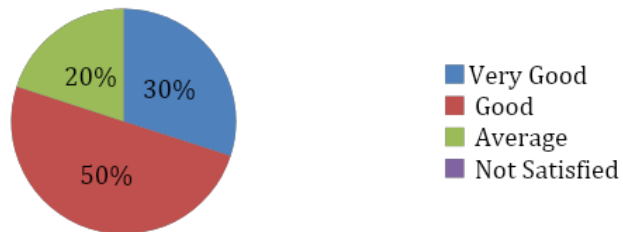

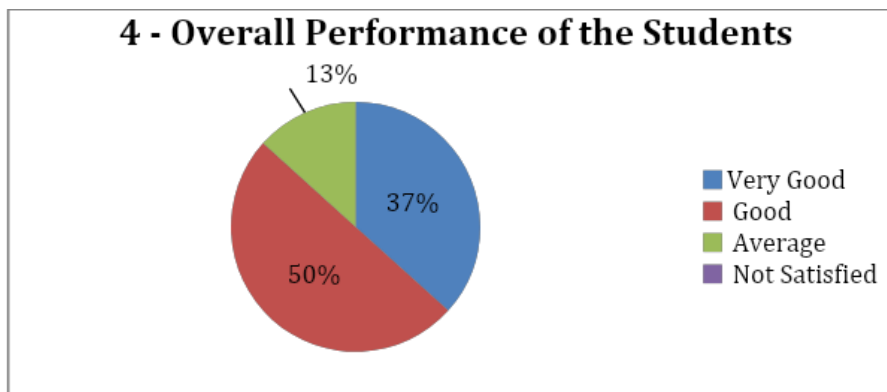

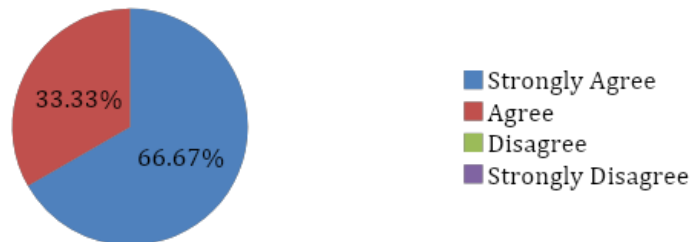

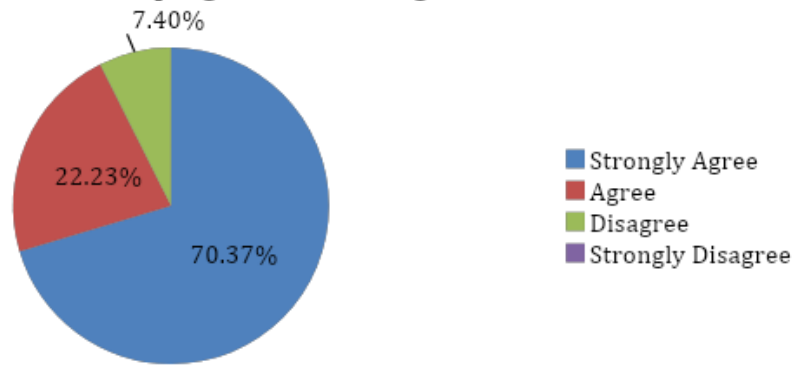

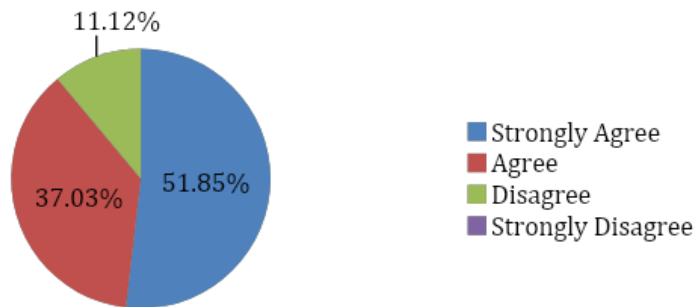

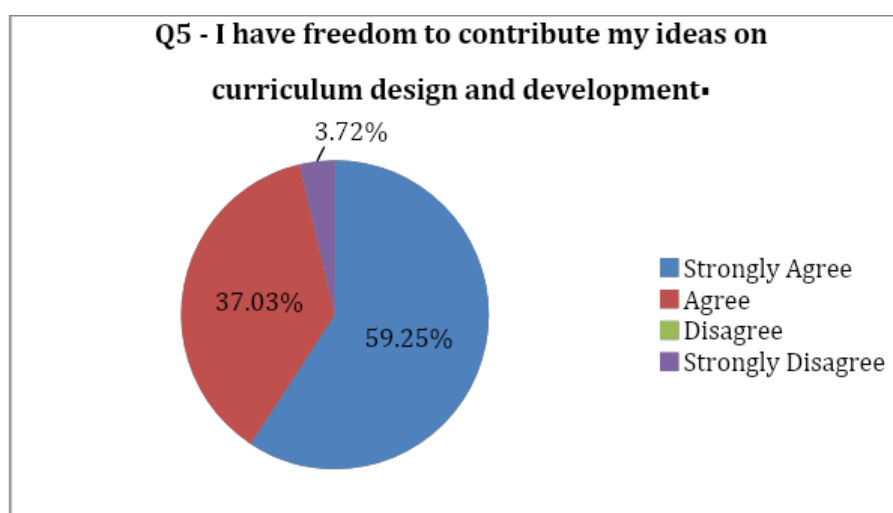

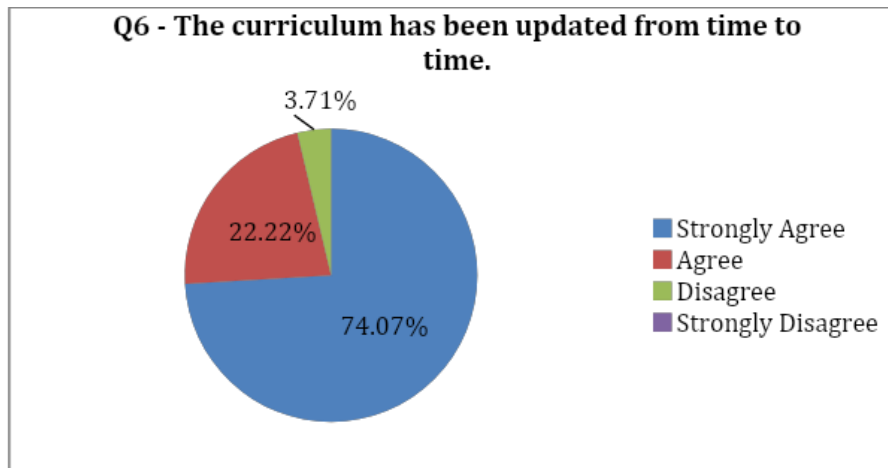
Q4 - Employability is given weightage in curriculum design and development.



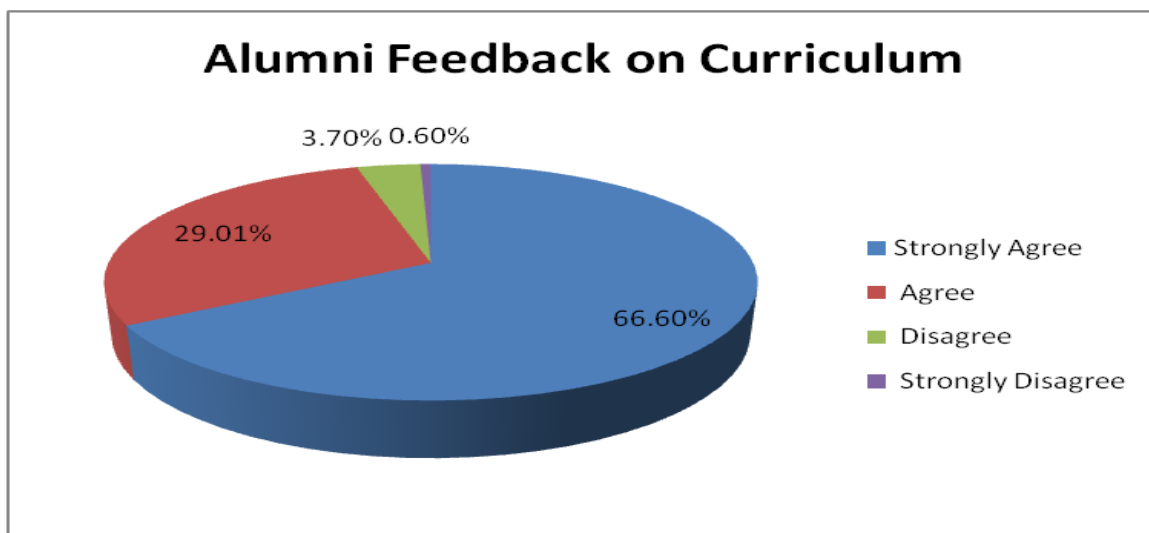
