Brief Report:

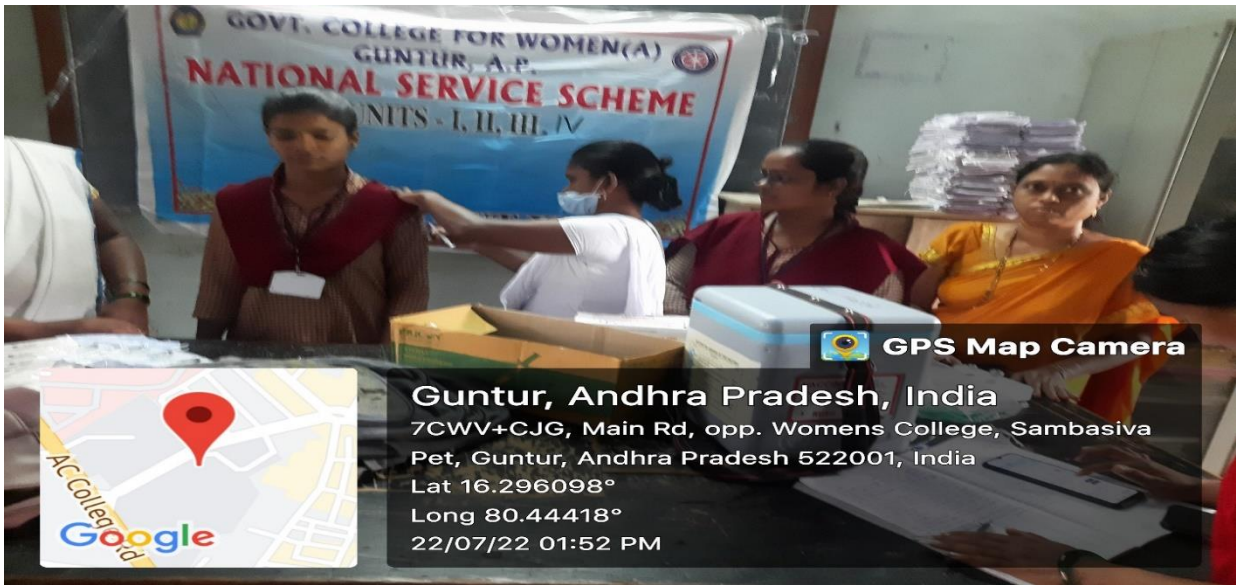

Breif Report:

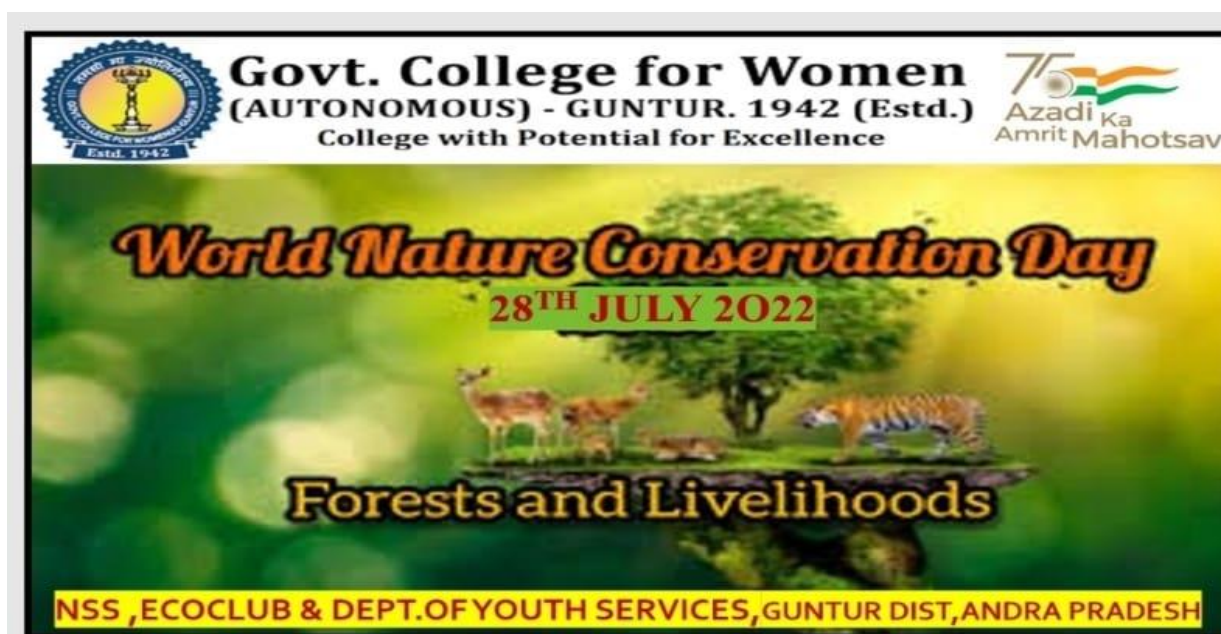

The students became responsible, patriotic, and socially aware citizens

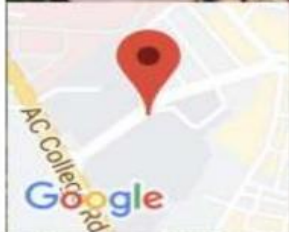

Brief History of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav and Har Ghar Tiranga:

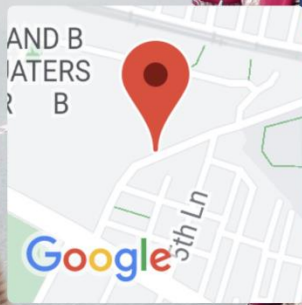

6. Brief history of National Unity Day:

His determination, political acumen, and persuasive skills were instrumental in unifying the diverse territories into a single nation.

The Government of India designated October 31 as National Unity Day in honor of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's contributions. The day serves as a reminder of the importance of national unity and the need to preserve the integrity of the nation.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, born on October 31, 1875, in Nadiad, Gujarat, was a prominent leader and statesman during India's struggle for independence. He played a pivotal role in shaping the political landscape of the country. As the first Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Home Affairs of independent India, Patel worked tirelessly to unify the princely states with the Indian Union.

After India gained independence, the country was divided into hundreds of princely states, each with its own ruler. Sardar Patel recognized the importance of bringing these states under a unified government to ensure stability, sovereignty, and progress for the newly independent nation. Through his diplomatic skills and persuasive negotiations, Patel convinced many princely states to accede to India. 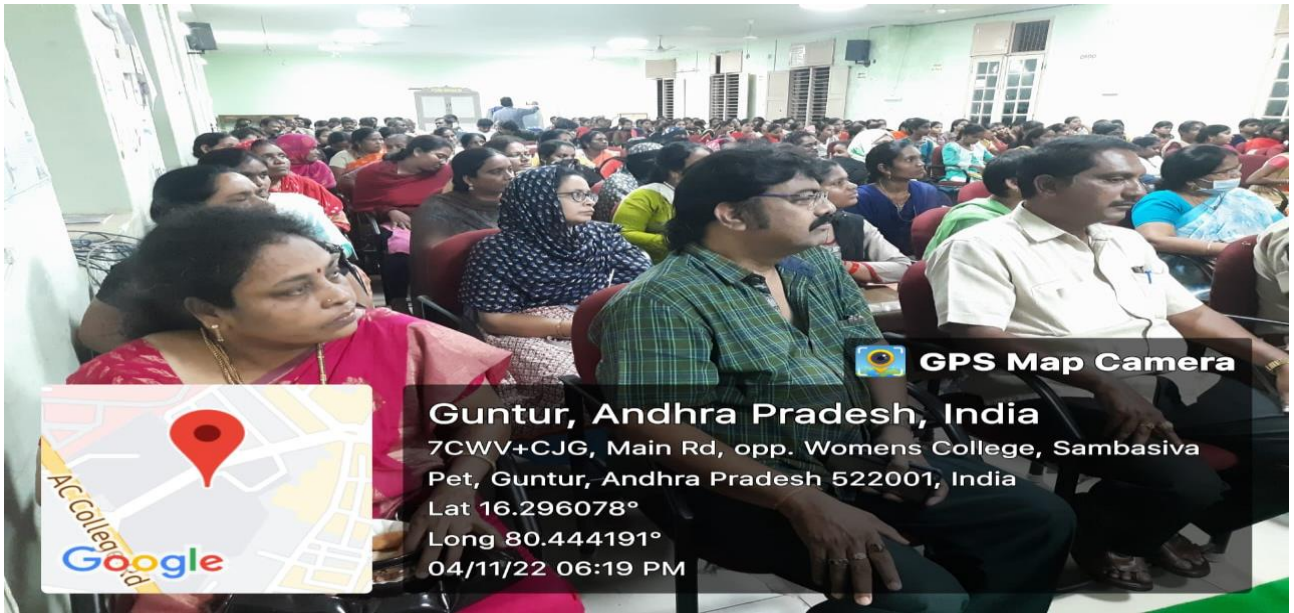

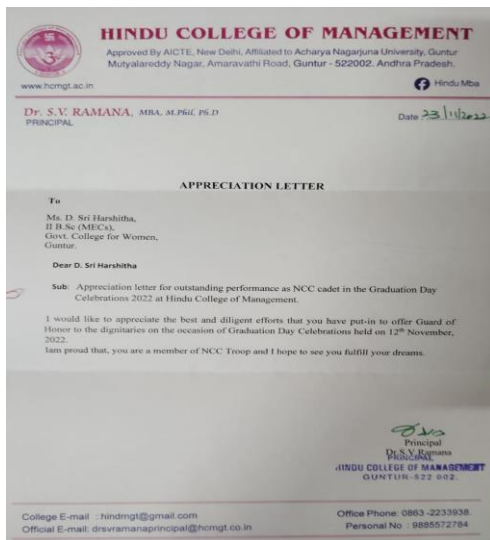

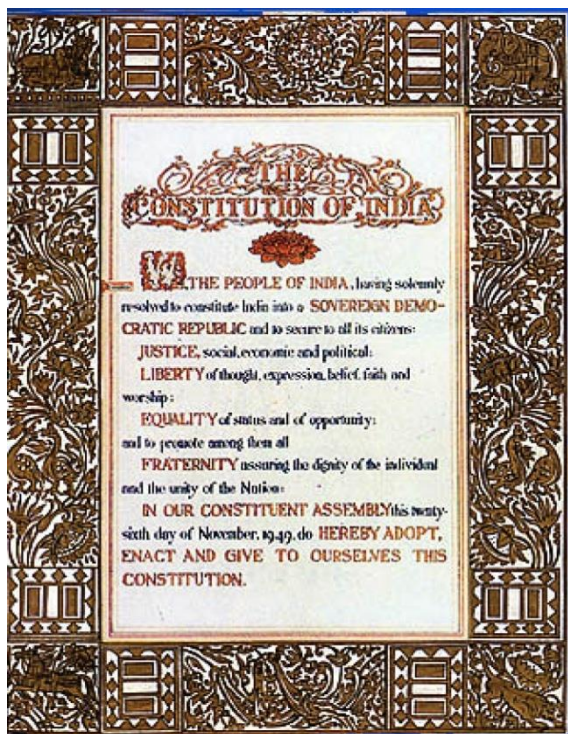


Activity Name: Constitution Day celebrations
