Procedure :

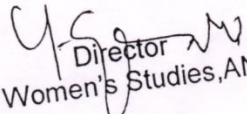

Activity 2 : Free Dental check-up camp

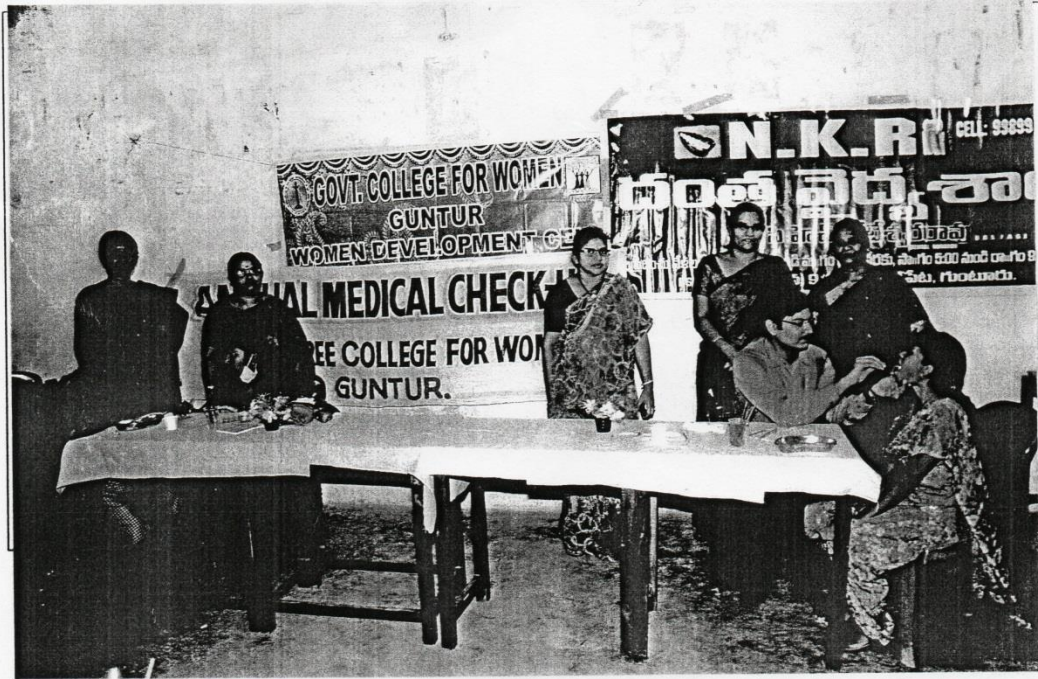
Objective :

Objective :

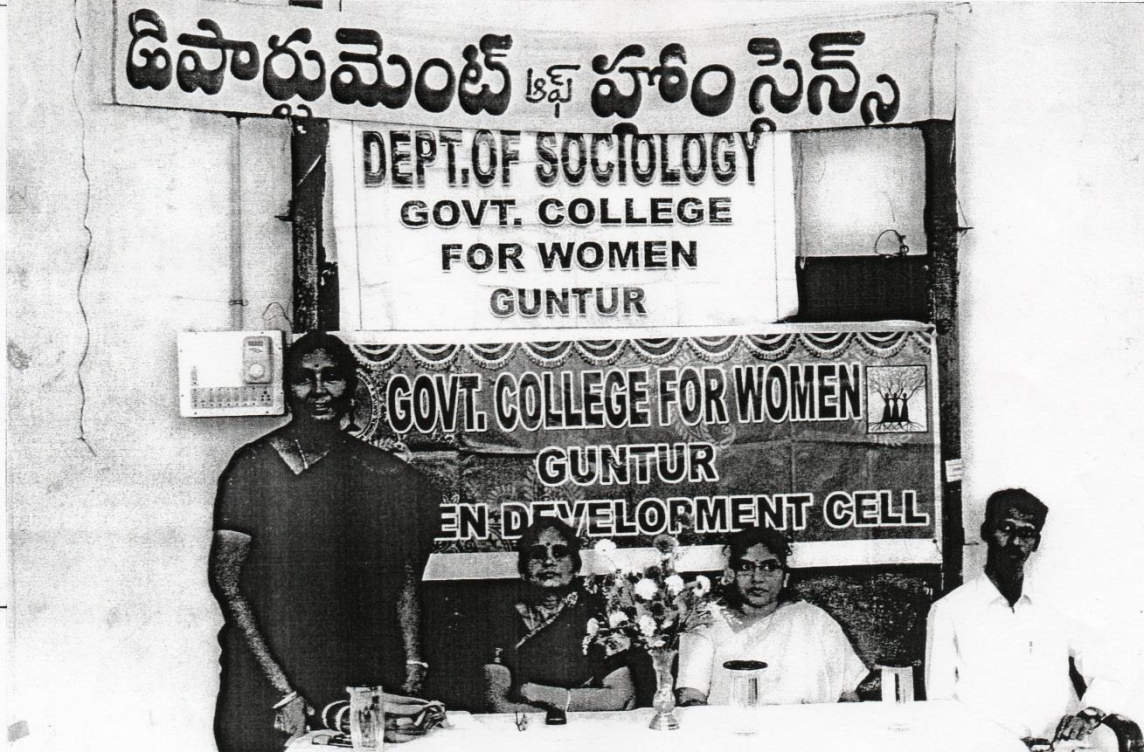
To Aware the students about the bad affects caused by child marriages

Activity 7 : .Short term certificate course in “Self Defence”

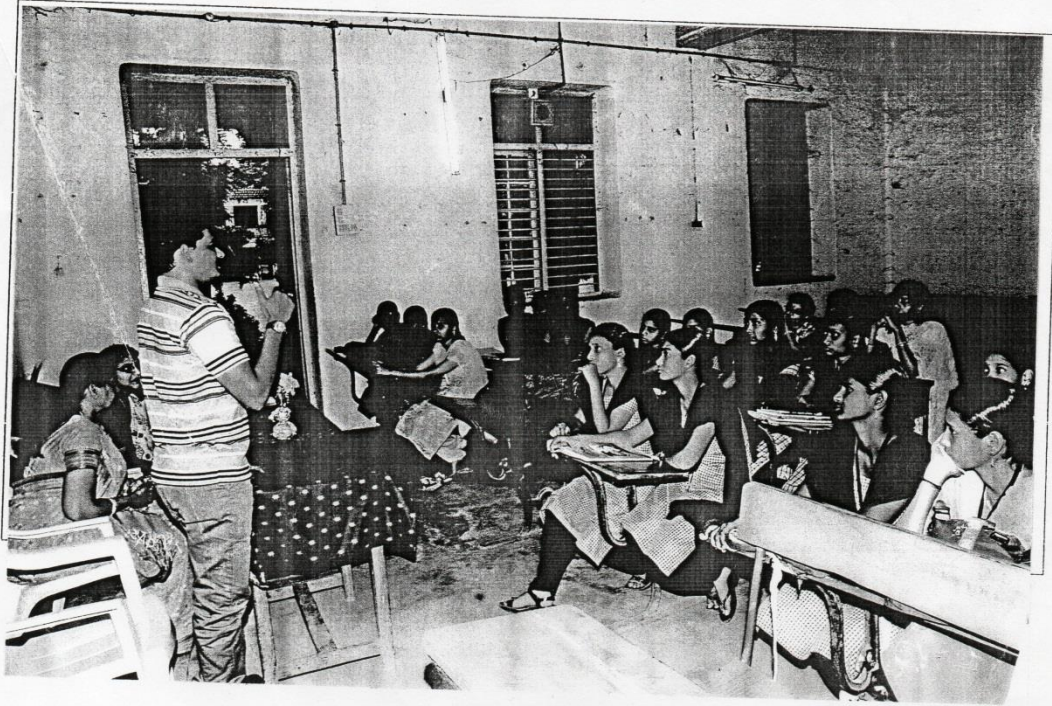
Objective :
