



Feedback Analysis report

Government College for Women (A), Guntur

Alumni Feedback Report- 2013-14

Established in the year 1942, Government College for Women maintains a good rapport with her Alumni for the past 76 years. Alumni meetings are organized by the college from time to time and feedback from Alumni is collected in the form of a questionnaire consisting of questions on Curriculum, Quality of Teaching, infrastructure, Activities organized by the college etc., Feedback from Alumni helps in identifying the measures required to ensure a better functioning of the system.

Feedback Analysis Summary:

1. Admission Procedure, Fee Structure and Scholarships: 50% of the Alumni members have rated the policies pertaining to Admission procedure as Excellent, 30% as Very Good and the remaining 20% as Good.
2. Faculty Interaction, Knowledge of Faculty, Quality of Support Material: 30% of the members are completely satisfied with the quality of teaching, resourcefulness of the teachers and support they have received from the faculty. 20% of the members have put it as Very Good and the remaining 50% have rated it as Good.
3. Relevance and Usefulness of the Curriculum: Nearly 75% of the members felt that the curriculum offered by the college is useful in higher studies and profession.
4. Infrastructural Facilities: 40% of the members have rated the infrastructure as Excellent, 40% as Very Good, 10% as Good and the remaining 10% put it as average.
5. Placements: 30% of the members have opined that the placement assistance offered by the college is excellent, 40% opined that it is sufficient and the remaining 30% as Good.
6. Activities organized by the College: 90% of the members agreed that the activities organized by the college have promoted an all-round development.
7. Ward Counseling and Grievance Redressal: Alumni expressed their satisfaction over the Ward Counseling system and the immediate redressal of complaints

Over all Grading: 35% of Alumni members gave an excellent grade, 30% put it as Very Good, the remaining 35% put it as Good.
