The Government of Andhra Pradesh is taking the Ragging activity very seriously and action being initiated against the students involved and also the Institution responsible.

In this connection a toll free number **18004255314** has been created at Office of Commissioner of Collegiate Education, A.P., Hyderabad to receive complaints on Ragging. This is created to curb untoward activities of the students. This is created for the students of Higher Education Institutions of Andhra Pradesh Government.

The attention of the Principals of all Govt., Private Aided and Private Un Aided Degree Colleges is invited to the reference cited and they are requested to take immediate measures on the following issued:-

- a. Erect the Notice Boards in all conspicuous places of Higher Education Institutions and display Anti Ragging Provisions and Penalties as per A.P. Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 both in Telugu and English;
- b. Faculty must be sensitized on the provisions of the Act as well as on the panel consequences;
- c. Take immediate adequate measures such as seminars, workshops, lectures by police, district and legal authorities to sensitize the students;
- d. UGC Regulations on curbing the Menace of Ragging earlier issued to all Higher Education Institutions must be scrupulously followed;
- e. It is the responsibility of the Vice Chancellors and HODs of other Educational Institutions to ensure a safe campus/College life, conducive to welfare and development of students, is ensured for all students;
- f. All the Degree Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh are advised to ensure appointment of Warden, Deputy Warden and Resident Matron to all the hostels and ensure there is proper management of hostels run the campuses/College Premises. The regular employees available in the College shall be posted to the post of Warden and Deputy Warden;
- g. Principals are requested to display the details of Anti Ragging Committee with phone numbers in all conspicuous places of the Institution, immediately.

The Principals are requested to take the above measures and send compliance immediately.
