- ❖ In accordance with the University and UGC regulations on the prevention and prohibition of ragging, an Anti-Ragging Committee has been formed at our institution. The primary objective of this committee is to eliminate the practice of ragging, which includes any form of behavior—verbal or physical—that may cause annoyance, hardship, psychological harm, fear, or apprehension to any student.
- ❖ Ragging encompasses acts like teasing, rudeness, unfair means, undisciplined activities, or any behavior that leads to shame, torment, or embarrassment to a fresher or any student. This behavior is strictly prohibited to ensure the physical and psychological well-being of all students.
