Action Taken Report on Feedback 2024-25

Online feedback on curriculum is collected and analysed by the internal quality assurance cell by the stakeholders i.e students, employers, alumni and faculty twice a year. Feedback is collected on programmes and courses and also on teaching methods. The analysis reports and sample forms are made available on college website.

Feedback on courses from students:

As per the recommendations of feedback analysis report of 2023-24, topics related to employability skills were introduced in the 2024-25 curriculum. The feedback on courses for the academic year 2024-25 is collected and analysed into a detailed report with suggestions for the betterment of the curriculum. Departments have been suggested to follow the recommendations for the better curriculum. The departments are recommended to update the curriculum with the current knowledge of AI and the Indian knowledge system. The Science departments are recommended to include new experimental techniques by introducing advanced equipment. The Arts departments are advised to introduce digital learning concepts in their curriculum. The departments are instructed to include gender based courses in the curriculum.


Feedback from teachers:
